## Code of Ethics

I will comply with the Code of Ethics of the Ontario College of Reflexology:

### **A. Service To The Public:**

- I. I vow to practice my profession with conscience and dignity.
- II. I will strive to apply my skills only with the utmost respect for the well-being of humanity.
- III. I will not permit considerations of nationality, politics, prejudice or material advancement to intervene between my work and this duty.
- IV. Without exception to all who seek my service, my first duty is to my client as governed by applicable statutes of the province of Ontario as required.
- V. I will direct and encourage my client to seek alternative counsel of particularly skilled professionals where indicated for the benefit of my client.
- VI. I will follow that method of treatment which according to my ability and judgement, I consider for the benefit of my client and abstain from whatever is harmful.
- VII. I will preserve absolute secrecy on all I know about my client because of the confidence entrusted in me.
- VIII. My place of business and person will function under highest hygienic standards.
- IX. I will not tread on medical grounds by diagnosing, prescribing for or for treating specific illnesses.

### **B. Service To The Profession:**

- I. I will behave to my colleagues as I would have them behave unto me with no judgement of competency.
- II. I will not entice clients from my colleagues.
- III. I will display fees, uphold proper bookkeeping and keep records at a legal and professional level while making receipts available.
- IV. I will work to complement and enhance all other health modalities - never to oppose or replace them.
- V. I will keep an open mind to new disciplines and discoveries in reflexology and other related fields.
- VI. I will serve my clients with the highest competence known to me to further enhance the credibility of reflexology.
- VII. I make this Oath solemnly, freely and upon my honour.
